 **The Week Ahead**
Twenty Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

• **Sunday 16**
Is 50:5-9, 114:1-6, 8-9, St Mark 8:27-35
Peter, acknowledging Jesus as the Christ, finds it hard to accept that Jesus must suffer and die because of who he is. So also Christians find it hard to accept the Cross as an integral part of their identity.

• **Monday 17**
1 Cor 11:17-26, 33, Psalm 39:7-10, 17, St Luke 7:1-10
The tradition of the Eucharist that Paul has handed on involves more than just the ritual action. It also means really recognising the presence of Christ in the gathered community. There must be no divisions among them as they come together to celebrate the memorial of the Lord.

St Robert Bellarmine, 1542-1621, Jesuit, Cardinal Bishop of Capua, involved in theological controversies of the time. Patron of catechists.

• **Tuesday 18**
1 Cor 12:12-14, 27-31, Psalm 99, St Luke 7:11-17
When Paul speaks of the community of faith as a body, he really means to relate it to the living physical body. Each member lives only as a part of the whole body; once amputated it is dead.

• **Wednesday 19**
1 Cor 12:31-13:13, Psalm 32:2-5, 12, 22, St Luke 7:31-35
Amidst the arguments and controversies there are three things that will endure: faith, hope and love, and the greatest of these is love.
St Januarius, Bishop of Benevento, was martyred at Naples in 305 with six companions.


• **Thursday 20**
1 Cor 15:1-11, Psalm 117:1-2, 15-17, 28, St Luke 7:36-50
Jesus teaches the Pharisees lessons on forgiveness and compassion for sinners when the woman anoints his feet with ointment.
Andrew Kim Tae-gon, the first Korean priest, Paul Chong Ha-sang, a catechist, and 101 others were martyred during the persecutions of the Church in Korea, 1839-67.

• **Friday 21**
Eph 4:1-7, 11-13, Psalm 18:2-5, St Matthew 9:9-13
St Matthew, the tax collector, may also be identified with Levi, son of Alphaeus, in Mark 2:13. He is said to have been a missionary in Persia and Ethiopia. Patron of accountants,

book-keepers, tax-collectors, customs officers and security guards.
Dublin Today is the anniversary of the Episcopal ordination of Most Rev Raymond Field, 21 September 1997.

• **Saturday 22**
1 Cor 15:35-37, 42-49, Psalm 55:10-14, St Luke 8:4-15

As we have shared in the fall of Adam by the fact that we shall die, so we shall share in the resurrection of Christ with a risen body like his.
