 **The Week Ahead**
Third Sunday of Easter 2018

• **Sunday 15**
Acts 3:13-15, 17-19, Psalm 4:2, 4, 7, 9,
St Luke 24:35-48
The signs that Jesus gives are to be understood by faith. So we see Peter preaching conversion as he has been told to do. Conversion is possible because Christ stands as our advocate before the Father.

• **Monday 16**
Acts 6:8-15, Psalm 118:23-24, 26-27, 29-30,
St John 6:22-29
Stephen, filled with grace and power, witnesses to Christ, becomes a threat to the synagogue and is arrested. Jesus tells the people to look beyond the bread they eat to the mystery, and to seek him in faith.

• **Tuesday 17**
Acts 7:51-8:1, Psalm 30:3-4, 6-8, 17, 21,
St John 6:30-35
Stephen becomes the first to die for Christ, echoing his Master's words of forgiveness for his executioners. Jesus is the Father's gift, sent to us on a life-giving mission.

• **Wednesday 18**
Acts 8:1-8, Psalm 65, 1-7,
St John 6:35-40
The persecution of the Church in Jerusalem under Saul sends the Christians to preach the good news elsewhere. **St Laserian** (Molaise) worked in both Ireland and Scotland in the seventh century and later entered the monastery at Leighlin, where he became abbot. His monastery thrived and gave its name to the diocese established in 1110. He adopted Church discipline in accordance with the practices of Rome and introduced the Roman method of dating the celebration of Easter. Laserian died in 639.

• **Thursday 19**
Acts 8:26-40, Psalm 65:8-9, 16-17, 20,
St John 6:44-51
The Ethiopian official was humble enough to ask to have the Scriptures explained to him. Philip's opening up of the word of God brought the man to faith and Baptism. We also ought to search the Scriptures daily.

• **Friday 20**
Acts 9:1-20, Psalm 116,
St John 6:52-59
The conversion of St Paul comes through his meeting with the risen Lord on the Road to Damascus. It is the same risen Lord who gives himself to believers in the Eucharist in a personal communion. That communion is a pledge of an eternal communion with Jesus and the Father.

• **Saturday 21**
Acts 9:31-42, Psalm 115:12-17,
St John 6:60-69
The churches built themselves up and were filled with the consolation of the Holy Spirit. Peter raises Dorcas to life on his apostolic journey. The words of Jesus lead to life, and give life if accepted in faith. **St Anselm** from Lombardy joined the monastic school of Bec in Normandy in 1059 under the direction of Lanfranc whom he succeeded as Archbishop of Canterbury. He was exiled twice and died in 1109.
